Houghton Lake Bobcat Boosters

Lou Ann Pacheco, President of the Houghton Lake High School Bobcat Athletic Booster Club, presented information to the Rotary Club of Houghton Lake at the September 8, 2003 meeting about the Booster Club's accomplishments for the 2002/2003 year and the upcoming projects and events for the 2003/2004 year. Lou Ann has been a member of the Booster Club for 12 years and she has served as President for 8 years.

Last year, the Booster Club spent a total of \$27,663.00 on scholarships, uniforms, warm-ups, busing for Spring sports, and JV coaches salaries for Spring sports.

This year, the Booster Club is taking over the production of the school calendar, which was discontinued by the school as a result of the budget reductions that took place at the end of last year. The Booster Club will be selling the calendars for \$3 each as a fundraiser. Proceeds from the sale of the calendars will benefit the activities of the HLHS Bobcat Athletic Booster Club and the Jack Pacheco Memorial Scholarship Fund.

The winner of a raffle that will be drawn on October 3rd at the Houghton Lake High School Bobcat Field at half-time of the Homecoming game will drive home a 2003 Chrysler PT Cruiser. Tickets are on sale now for \$100 each. There will be a minimum of 300 tickets sold and a 400 ticket maximum. All proceeds will go to the Booster Club. Tickets are available from Bobcat Booster members or at the Houghton Lake High

School. If 300 tickets are not sold, the drawing will revert to a 50/50 raffle with a minimum prize of \$10,000 awarded.

This year's sports program is dedicated to Jack Jury. Jack retired as the high school counselor at the end of last year.

The Booster Club is always looking for volunteers to help in the concession stand, selling items, or taking tickets at the gate.

In closing, Lou Ann shared a fond memory of the last time she attended a Rotary meeting several years ago when both she and her husband were honored by the Rotary Club of Houghton Lake.
