Roscommon County Fair

There are several new plans underway for the fair, many of which have been the work and ideas of the new Youth Fair Board. Among these new events will be a Queen's contest, a teen dance, pig races, a dog show, a family barn dance, and a worship service. A rodeo will be held on August 14th, and there is a demolition derby pre-fair event that will be held on June 5th. The fair will continue with other events such as the animal auctions, the carnival, and of course, the 4H horse show.

Many new improvement projects are being planned at the fairgrounds as well including a new kitchen area, an arena, bleachers, and expanding the livestock divisions. 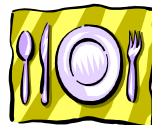
