World Community Service project

Joe McGinnis from the Missaukee County Rotary, and three Lake City High School students presented to the Rotary Club of Houghton Lake on April 19, 2004. Joe is the Athletic Director at Lake City High School and, with a group from Lake City, he has traveled to Costa Rica twice and to Belize once. In Belize, he visited a baboon sanctuary. In the middle of the sanctuary is a museum that is literally falling apart. The people of Belize want to rebuild the museum, as they have no other way of protecting their artifacts. They need \$6,000 to rebuild the museum. Joe brought the idea back to his Rotary Club for a World Community Service project. The Missaukee County Rotary has donated \$1,500 and Joe is asking other clubs in the District to donate to this cause as well. The Governor wants 100% participation in World Community Service in our District.

Joe has been in contact with the three Rotary Clubs in Belize. He's unable to get monetary donations from any of them, however he has asked one of the Clubs to oversee the project once it gets started. Joe would like to go to Belize again when the project is complete.

The students shared their travel experiences with us. They described the country of Belize as having only

one airport and only 4 paved roads. They stayed in huts with mosquito nets over the beds, however, they did have running water and electricity. There are no police and no speed limits. The weather was humid and the temperatures were in the 80's and 90's.

Our inbound exchange student, Susanna Vuorinen, still has a couple of conferences coming up. Is anyone interested in getting to know her by taking and/or picking her up from these conferences?

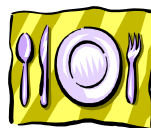
