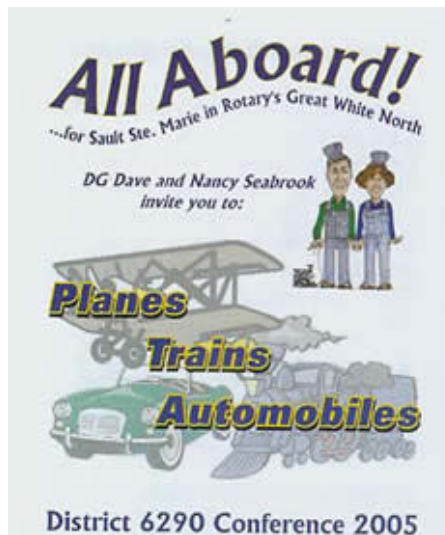

Tammy Jo Gandolfi presented to the Rotary Club of Houghton Lake on August 1, 2005. Tammy Jo gave an update on the New Day Preschool in Houghton Lake. New Day Preschool was founded in 1963 as a preschool playgroup and was called "Houghton Lake Nursery". The program moved around for a number of years to different buildings until locating to its current facility on Emery Road. New Day is the only co-op preschool in Roscommon County. The facility is 100% donated and community owned. New Day has programs for 3 year olds and 4 year olds. The 3 year olds attend two or three days per week in the afternoons and the 4 year olds attend three or four days per week in the mornings. The 4 year olds work on preK skills. The preschool employs two teachers and one aide. Recent concerns, like most educational institutions right now, are lower enrollments and rising costs. They are currently putting together a new marketing program for the preschool.
