Thank you Lowell, Houghton Lake and Muskegon Rotary Clubs for helping make this project possible. This will be the first International Aid Lab in a Suitcase provided in the Dominican Republic. The total cost \$2700 and gives the ability to do the majority of basic lab tests. The government of DR will provide training for a technician to operate the equipment. You can see Sally Ernst, St Joe/Benton Harbor Rotarian and flight attendant, had the pleasure of hand delivering the equipment.

The clinic serves 60-80 patients each day. Clearly they will be better served with the help of this lab. Thanks to other Rotary clubs they have a new building to put the lab and this will be the first time the clinic has had this type of equipment available for its doctor.
