Seabrook Challenge – discussion of need to support the program. Last year 19 members donated \$50 each to support the relief program. The remaining members will be billed for the payment in two installments of \$25 for the next 2 quarters. This payment will be on a voluntary basis. World Community Service Trip to Dominican Republic will be February 3 – 10, 2006. Debbie Banks will be attending the trip. Deposit of \$252 has been paid and the balance of \$997 will be paid for Debbie to go. Motion by Anita Sheppard supported by Randy Seymour.

John Stark spoke of a cruise trip offer that he has received from Jan Shaughnessy. This offer is for Rotarians to take a cruise at reduced prices. John will see if there is enough interest from members to have Ms Shaughnessy make a presentation. Motion by Anita Sheppard supported by Debbie Banks. Stacey Barnes has agreed to be the chairperson for the TUT Chili-cookoff fundraiser. She gave a presentation to the board of the plans so far. Several things were discussed regarding entry fees, charges to public, serving ideas, health/safety issues, cost/income, etc. Motion by Randy Seymour supported by Tom Moreau to give her a working budget of \$1,000.00.

Aid to Hurricane Katrina was discussed and all the requests that John is getting from other rotary organizations. John will look into sending aid directly to a rotary organization in the area so the relief goes where needed the most. He will report at a later date.

New members have not given "classification speeches" in over a year. Discussion was held on the importance of getting to know all members. The speeches will be done each week by the person who is designated to procure the speaker for the week. Each speech will be 5 minutes in length and the outline will be presented to the person the week before the speech is to be given.
