Morry McLain presented to the Rotary Club of Houghton Lake on October 3, 2005. Morry gave us an update on the Houghton Lake Chamber of Commerce. The Chamber is going through some reorganization—they are trying to not have to hire an executive director, a position that is currently vacant. They are hoping that the Board will step up and run the Chamber with the help of the office staff. They are communicating and meeting with other Chambers to get some insight and new ideas. In the process of establishing the budget this year, the Chamber has based the budget on membership dues only, not on event profits.

Some of the current projects that the Chamber is involved with are the Pumpkin Run, a circus, a magic show (coming up on 10/21 at The Playhouse), the Pumpkin Run raffle, a Hunter's Ball, Tip-up-Town, and snowmobile trail grooming. The Chamber is trying to restore a sense of community in Houghton Lake and they are hoping that some of these new events will help with that goal.

Tip-up-Town is the biggest event that the Chamber sponsors. This year, Tip-up-Town will have a whole new look, lots of new events and new rides. Tip-up-Town will truly be a family-oriented festival. Applications for queen and for mayor/marshall are now downloadable from the Tip-up-Town website:
