Mary Frey, Executive Director of the Roscommon County Community Foundation (RCCF), presented to the Rotary Club of Houghton Lake on August 7, 2006.

The mission of RCCF is to enhance the quality of life for all citizens of Roscommon County, now and for generations to come, by attracting and holding permanent endowment funds from a wide variety of donors, by addressing community needs through awarding grants from the income of these endowment funds, and by providing leadership on key community issues.

RCCF has over 30 established endowment funds that support grants in Roscommon County in the areas of education and scholarships, environmental, housing, recreation, youth, and other categories. Mary brought our attention to one of the funds called the Houghton Lake Rotary Club General Fund, which was established with an initial pledge of \$30,000 from the Club to be applied to the greatest needs in the Houghton Lake/Prudenville area as directed by the Rotary Club. To date, we have not disbursed any money from this fund and there is some available. Our Club is very proud to have several of our members on the RCCF Board of Trustees, including Dick Brown, Jim Kent, Tom Moreau, Bob Pacella, and Randy Seymour.

Lastly, Mary invited all of us to attend the "Taste of Roscommon County" donor appreciation celebration to be held at East Bay Lodge on August 20th from 2-4:30 pm. 9 restaurants in Roscommon County will participate this year.
