General Meeting of Rotary Club of Houghton Lake held at Coyles- September 11, 2006

Community Service: Nancy Moss discussed her involvement with a literacy program. She presented a book to the club and asked for members' help with a Dictionary Project to get dictionaries into the hands of children in the community.

“What One Rotary Club Can Do, Another Rotary Club Can Do”

District #6290 Governor Don Moss presented a motivational program to the membership. He used a power point presentation with movie scenes to depict, “What one human being can do, another can do!” He modified this to Rotarians and Rotary Clubs and had the club members repeat, “What one Rotary Club can do, another Rotary Club can do!”

Governor Moss used well-known slogans to depict, ‘What is Rotary?’ Rotary is the **Ideal of Service** ... ‘Everybody can be great, because everybody can *serve*’, and ‘Dreaming, after all, is planning’. He noted some of the dreams that have come true in Rotary:

- 1985-Polio eradication started. Only four countries are left: India, Nigeria, Pakistan, Afghanistan.
- National Immunization Day
- Bali Blood Banks-inspired by a woman who was involved in a Group Study Exchange in Bali.
- Bio Sand Filters*- for water access and quality to reduce poverty and disease. *Matching grants are available for filter systems in the Dominican Republic.

Governor Moss challenged the members to DREAM and ‘let Rotary become for each of you more than a social club’. The club pointed out members who have recently *made a difference* to our club. He told all members to, “Be everything that you are capable of being. Please stand with me this year, individually, and as a club, and help me to *Lead the Way!*”

President Debbie presented Governor Moss and Nancy with Tip-Up-Town Sweatshirts from the club.
