General Meeting of Rotary Club of Houghton Lake held at Coyles— September 25, 2006

**Club and Community Information:** President Debbie informed the membership of Deb Dawson's death and viewing/funeral schedule. Carolyn Krompetz is doing okay during her recovery from surgery. John Stark's Mother is ill and he may make a decision to take a leave of absence. Signage for the club's Adopt-a-Highway route will be researched. **District News:** The Conference starts this week, Sep. 28 – Oct. 1 at Boyne Falls, MI. Governor Moss has sent information on Celebrating the Diversity of World Cultures. He explains that September 24<sup>th</sup> is Ramadan which starts the 9<sup>th</sup> month on the Islamic calendar devoted to the commemoration of Muhammad's reception of the divine revelation as recorded in the Qur'an. He notes that September 22-23 celebrates Rosh Hashana, which is the Jewish New Year.

**Classification Speech:** Given by Honorary member, Reverend Jim Kent. He highlighted why he became interested in this Rotary Club, noting that we were generous to Habitat when Habitat started in the county, and that, "We do the Impossible!"

### Today's Program-Habitat for Humanity (H-H):

Jim Kent informed the club that the For Sale signs in the area can demonstrate the way things are for Habitat for Humanity, also. The success for H-H is to get money outside of Roscommon County, but in 2000 incoming money slowed down and in 2001 it came to a halt due to hurricanes, tsunamis, etc., and money flowed south for those peoples' needs. There are transitions occurring such as, Debbie Bank's moving on as Executive Director and Misty Klatt moving into this position. This Rotary Club has built nine of the 43 H-H houses in the county. There are currently two houses that did not get finished this year due to lack of funding, and the families are in great need of getting into these homes. He claims that 'tough times' require 'tough people' and that those involved with H-H are smart enough to make it happen. Jim stressed the need for younger people into H-H as is needed in Rotary, so these groups can continue to benefit this community. To help celebrate ONE MILLION dollars in grants received and ONE MILLION dollars in mortgages that have been written, Habitat for Humanity is hosting a Million Dollar Party & Live Art Auction on Sunday, October 1, 2006 at Comfort Suites Lakeside. Invitations were dispersed.

President Debbie presented Jim and Misty with a \$1500 check for Habitat for Humanity on behalf of the Rotary club.
