The Foundation funds the Group Study Exchange (GSE), Ambassadorial Scholarships, and humanitarian projects, including Rotary's largest, Polio Plus, which has allowed a 99% reduction in the cases of polio throughout the world. Paul Harris, the founder of Rotary, was honored today, as well as those members of the Houghton Lake Rotary Club who are Paul Harris Fellows.

President Debbie has announced that she would like the club to utilize our Foundation Points that we have from past and terminated members, to match points that our members have, in an effort to try to bring them up to Paul Harris Fellowship. This will be further investigated in the near future.
