Notes from General Meeting of Rotary Club of Houghton Lake – May 21, 2007

Club and Community: President Debbie read a thank you note from Artesia Youth Park for money they received from the Rotary RCCF fund. She noted that John Stark's mother is very ill and in Hospice care. She noted that the Scholarship committee has selected recipients and she would like the Board to meet today for notification of names. Debbie announced that there would be no meeting next Monday due to Memorial Day.

Rotary Park: Tom McNamara reported that the Park Work Day went well. The Geodome is complete and needs to be secured to its base. Two more work days will be needed at the park. He scheduled a three hour session for Thursday, May 31, at 1:00 pm.

Bike Rodeo: Tom Moreau reported on the rodeo held on Saturday at the HLHS.

Although the weather was not cooperative, there were many Rotarians, spouses and students there to help. The location and accommodations were great, a lot of good food was donated by Glen's Market and there were 162 helmets and \$600 of prizes available for attendees, along with a bike giveaway. One child, Anthony Burtis, brought his used bike (in great condition) to give to a child in need. There were only 65 children in attendance and several did not have their bikes or helmets with them. This may have been due to the combined Health Fair/ID program and not enough exposure to those children to bring their equipment. Tom recommended that the club consider the location again next year, but plan to hold the Bike Rodeo separate from the other activities.

President Nominee: Denise MacKenzie, President Nominee, was unanimously approved as President of the HL Rotary Club for 2008-2009.

Checking Account: Bert Sisson stated that he had heard that the checking account at Chase Bank had been closed recently. President Debbie claimed that it only had \$600 in it and that she would bring it to the Board to take care of this.

Club Assembly: *Golf Outing*-Rick Hacker reported that the outing will be on Wednesday, August 1, 2007. In an effort to provide an outing to the public, the format will be for non-(HL) Rotarians. Rotarians will be in attendance to help run the outing; cooks are needed, as well as set-up and tear-down help. Advertising will be organized by Cindy Fuller and will involve advertisements on the golf carts. *International*-Dave Hanson discussed restarting the Rotary Youth Exchange Program in our club and the need for host families for 2008-2009. He noted that we would try to utilize the past outgoing exchange students from our club to help inspire students' involvement with the program. *Public Relations*-Gary Gandolfi requested that Rotarians bring in photos of club activities, as they can.
