Business meeting called to order at 12:31 pm by Past President, Randy Seymour.

Golf Outing: Scheduled for Wednesday, August 1, 2007. Format is 18 holes of golf with tee times, and option for Scramble following. Cost is to be determined; approximate cost is \$75 per golfer and includes dinner and beverages. No HL Rotarians will play golf at this outing—all Rotarians are expected to work at this event. Raffle tickets for \$1000 grand prize will be sold at \$1 each or 6 for \$5.

President Elect (PE) Comments: PE Carolyn Krompetz commented on the upcoming year's fundraising events-she would like to continue with the Auction and the Golf Outing for the major fundraisers. Randy Seymour paid a fine for humoring Carolyn by telling her to sit down after she commented that she would like to add another fundraiser.

Program: Camp Grayling Rock & Roll Air Show July 7 & 8, 2007

Dick Follrath introduced guest speaker, Mike Spielmaker, of Special Forces Ventures, Inc., who discussed the Air Show to be held at Camp Grayling and to include aerial acts and concerts, and intended for family fun. Mike has served 15 years in the Special Forces in the Army and has been the motivating factor in organizing this event, which is expected to bring 70,000-100,000 people into the area, per dictations by the media, i.e., radio and website: www.campgraylingairshow.com. The show includes the United States Army Golden Knights Parachute Team, the Blue Angels who will land there, along with many other aerial acts. The concerts include Molly Hatchet, Blackfoot, Foghat member Tony Stevens, along with many other Michigan Bands. Tickets are \$45.50 per adult, \$26.50 for 11-17 year old, and free to those 10 and under, and are available at all Meijer locations thru StarTicketsPlus & on the website. Parking is \$5.00. Gates open at 10:30 am; the show starts at 12:00 pm and ends at 9:00 pm, rain or shine. Friday, July 6 will be a free day for all and it will include aerial acts and a concert that evening. There are restrictions on what you can bring in and Mike advised consulting the website. He informed the club that they have a professional vending service contracted to keep the food prices down. He also noted that the show does not rely on tax money, and it is designed to benefit the surrounding communities, including Traverse City's Cherry Festival, by bringing people into the area.
