Report on the State of the District—Governor Don Moss

I have had a blast leading the District this year! What comes to mind are the wonderful fellowship and fun my wife Nancy and I have enjoyed with Rotarians from Wawa to Grand Rapids to Traverse City to Honduras! I have enjoyed roasting prime ribs on the Lake Superior beach, walking the girders of the international bridge, leaping into the icy water of the Rogue River, meeting our exchange students in Copenhagen, and a host of other memorable experiences. A great deal of important work has also been carried out this year, most of it by Rotary volunteers, and I think the District deserves an accounting. I will first give a short version of this year's accomplishments, and then provide more detail for those who want to know more.



- Incorporation:** District 6290 has nearly completed the process of incorporation.
- District Audit Process:** District 6290 has a new audit process for all committees with their own budgets and accounts.
- Youth Protection Policy:** District 6290 has a new Youth Protection Policy approved by Rotary International and the Council for Standards for International Educational Travel.
- Vision Facilitation:** District 6290 has a new team of trainers, which has conducted strategic planning sessions for eight Rotary Clubs.
- District Conference Process:** District 6290 has a new budgetary and planning process for the District Conference.
- World Community Service:** District 6290 continued to lead the way in world community service, with an impressive number of humanitarian projects abroad, and growing participation in the annual Thirsting to Serve Water Conference.
- Foundation Progress:** District 6290 held a Foundation Banquet attended by 137 persons at the Crystal Mountain Resort and chartered a new Paul Harris Society.
- Youth Service:** Rotary youth service continues to grow in District 6290 with at least two new Interact Clubs, a new Strive program, and a new Rotaract Club in process. Youth Exchange and Life Leadership continue to be exemplary programs.
