

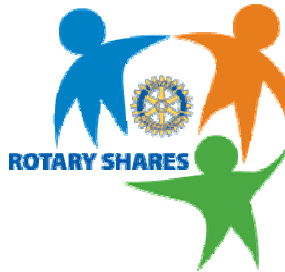

Club, Community and District: Carolyn Krompetz presented Debbie Banks with a Paul Harris Fellow award. Jim Kent presented a poem and card to Debbie Banks. Carolyn reported that David Hanson has paperwork started for the Exchange Student program for the 2007-2008 school year. There are no candidates in place at this time for an outgoing or an incoming exchange student.

Park Update: Tom McNamara requested volunteers for a park work day. The date agreed upon is this Thursday, July 12th at 5pm.
