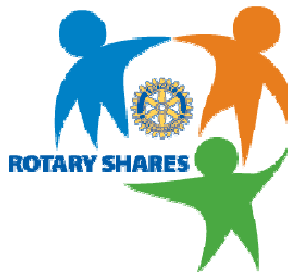

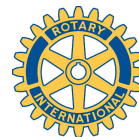

Minutes of the General Meeting of Rotary Club of Houghton Lake held at Artesia Youth Park – August 13, 2007

Business meeting called to order at 12:30 pm by President, Carolyn Krompetz.

Club, Community and District: Carolyn read an email from our District Governor regarding an urgent issue. The DG is urging all clubs in our district to vote in opposition to Enactment 07-231. This Enactment expanded the number of members on the Nominating Committee for Rotary International President from 17 to 34. These committee members come from zones all around the world and speak different languages. The reason for the opposition is the belief that increasing the members required for the committee would significantly increase the cost to Rotary due to increased travel, lodging, translation and meeting expenses. Our club has 2 votes toward this issue and has to make a decision by Monday, August 27th. Copies of the email will be at the next meeting for anyone that would like more information before the club votes.

Park: Denise reported of an incident where a community member thought that the park was only for Denton Township residents. Denise suggested putting up a sign to address that the park is open to the public. Dick Follrath reported that someone suggested that the park should have a baby swing. Tom McNamara will check into these issues.

Program: JoJean informed the club on the progress and future plans at Artesia Youth Park. The facility will be primarily targeted for kids ages 9-18. The hours may be expanded at a later date to accommodate other members/age groups of the community to be able to utilize the facility. There will be a main activity center-activities offered will be generated by the kids' interest and the skills of the volunteers. There will be a weight room, exercise room, cardio machines, game tables, kitchen and stage area for music. There is also a skate park. The project has 7 phases and they are currently in phase 2. JoJean discussed the Rotary Club sponsoring bus rides for transporting kids to and from the park. One way we could do that is to give the Park a donation, either a one time or ongoing (as needed), that would be put into their Transportation Fund from which they would pay the bus service. Initially the park will be open 2 days a week and they estimate about 25 or more kids a day –estimated cost would be about \$200 + a week for transportation. There are openings on the Artesia Youth Park board to help develop programs and security if anyone is interested.
