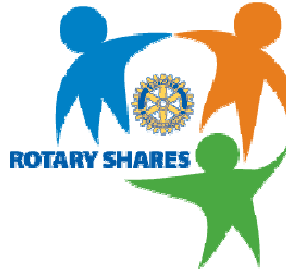

Minutes of the General Meeting of Rotary Club of Houghton Lake held at Coyles– September 17, 2007

Meeting opened at 12:15 pm with song, Pledge of Allegiance and prayer. Business meeting called to order at 12:30 pm by President, Carolyn Krompetz.

Club, Community and District: Carolyn reported that Bert Sisson had an emergency appendectomy. Reminder-The District Governor will be here next week. Committee heads need to give updates to Debbie to complete the booklet showcasing our club activities that will be given to the District Governor. Bob Gandolfi volunteered to take the DG on a tour around town to show her the club projects. Tom Moreau volunteered to handle the Citizen of the Year award-he has one nominee so far. Carolyn thanked Denise for her work on membership.

Fundraising: Sindy reported that we are still waiting for Kirtland to receive the script for Tony & Tina's Wedding and an official okay from them before the committee can move forward with plans.

Program: Andy Vokes from the Crawford-Roscommon Conservation District Groundwater Stewardship Program displayed how water moves through different soil types. Less than 1% of the water on the planet is fresh and available for drinking. Some information he reported: households with wells should have tap water tested yearly, high nitrates in water are dangerous for children and pregnant women, removing vegetation from lakefront property removes a barrier that allows fertilizer to run into the lake contaminating the water, the best time to fertilize your lawn is early in the morning when there is a lot of dew and no rain in the forecast, and the best care for septic is to reduce the amount of household cleaning products you use/put down the drain. To test your water contact the Health Department get a water test kit, take samples and send to a lab. Best results are when you take out the trap, run water for 10 minutes first and use cold water-don't test softened water

Program next week is the District Governor's visit.

This months board meeting will be held with the District Governor on 9/24 at 10:30am at Coyles in the side room. The Interact Board will also be invited.

Meeting adjourned at 1:10 pm.
