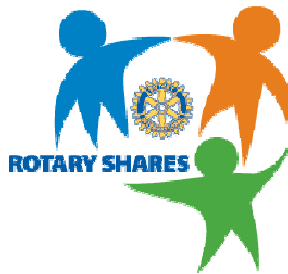

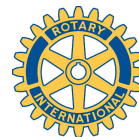

Program: District Governor Chris Etienne, a 16 year member of the Rotary Club of Petoskey, informed and updated us on Rotary projects and goals. She started a program called Where in the World is Chris Etienne, where through a link on the Rotary website you can follow her travels as she travels around to different clubs in our district. She talked about this year's theme-Rotary Shares-and how Rotarians share their time, love, fellowship and friendship. She stressed the importance of growing Rotary membership. She stated that 80% of all members have not recruited a new member. The new Rotary Sponsor pin has been created in order to encourage members to recruit. Of all the projects Rotary is involved in, this year's emphasis is on literacy, health and hunger, and clean water. November 12-16th is Polio Plus week. Rotary's goal is to have \$10 per member donated towards Polio Plus. Also, if every club has their members give \$100 per year to Rotary International, Rotary would have an Ambassadorial Scholar every year. This month is Youth in the Community month and she was impressed to see how involved our club is with Interact.
