

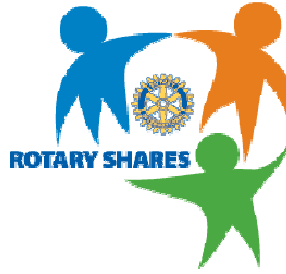

Business meeting called to order at 12:30 pm by President, Carolyn Krompetz.

Club, Community and District: A motion was made by Tom Rose to change the bylaws by striking the sentence "two signatures shall be required on all checks" and was seconded by Debbie Banks. After club discussion the club voted against the motion; motion failed. The club bylaws will remain as written. A motion was made by Debbie Banks to change the bylaws to state checks under \$250 do not require two signatures and was seconded by Denise. After the required 10 day waiting period for a bylaw change, this motion will be brought to the club for discussion and a vote.

Vocational Award: Tom Moreau handed out ballots to nominate candidates for the Vocational Award. Nominees can be a Rotarian or a non-Rotarian. Please complete the ballots and bring to the next meeting. The Citizen of the Year award will be at a later date. (The ballot states Citizen of the Year in error-this is for Vocational Award.)

Strive: There are about 43 students that could be prospective members.

Interact: Bill reported that the Interact Club met last week and have a lot of good ideas. They meet the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of every month at 3pm in the cafeteria.

State Update: Pete Injasoulion gave the club an update on the State. Michigan is ranked 50th in unemployment, 50th in economic momentum and in the middle in regards to the state's tax burden. Salaries rank in the top 5%. Some results from the state's budget resolution are the state income tax will increase from 3.9% to 4.35% and new taxes on businesses will be implemented. Pete reported that he and school board members attended a board member retreat this past weekend. They participated in Board/Superintendent relations exercises and covered topics such as intervention of kids with problems.

Program: Carolyn presented a check for \$1000 to Rhoda Hacker for River House. Rhoda explained that due to the limited storage space at River House for donations, that while all donations are appreciated, cash donations such as these are always helpful because it gives them the flexibility to spend it where it is most needed. Rhoda presented our club a certificate of appreciation in recognition of our support of River House. Rhoda informed the club about River House's major fundraiser, Weekend at River House, which is happening on October 13-14. Saturday, October 13 activities include an open house at the shelter with breakfast and a tour. The Saturday evening event is at the HL Playhouse from 6p-11pm and includes dinner, jazz music and a wine tasting. On Sunday there is a high tea from 1p-4p at Camp CoBeAc with music from Joel Sheltrown. There will be a raffle drawing on Sunday at 3pm. Prices range from \$10 - \$125 depending on what activities you choose to participate in.

Meeting adjourned at 1:10 pm.
