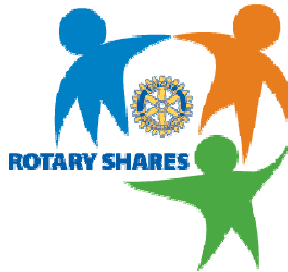

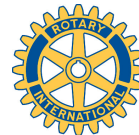

General Meeting of Rotary Club of Houghton Lake held at Coyles-November 5, 2007

Business meeting called to order at 12:30 pm by President, Carolyn Krompetz.

Club, Community and District: If anyone is interested in the Indonesia polio vaccinations, please let Carolyn know. Carolyn read a thank you letter from River House for our continued support. New members Paula Fuller and Kim Akin were inducted today. After the general meeting, Carolyn called an emergency board meeting to discuss whether or not our club would support the Chamber with a donation towards Tip Up Town. A motion was made by Debbie Banks to donate \$500, taken from the various small donations, towards Tip Up Town; seconded by Tom McNamara. Motion passed.

Interact: Bill Oliver reported that the Interact visit to Maple View went well. The club is selling tickets for \$1 for a chance to win 5 large pizzas from Hungry Howies.

Auction: Bill Oliver presented the budget for the 2008 Auction. A few changes from last year are an increase in the cost of food per person, an increase in the cost of the liquor liability insurance, and a decrease in the cost of linen rentals. Total budget amount is \$8550 + the cost of tickets and fliers. Tom McNamara and Denise MacKenzie have agreed to be team leaders. Gary Gandolfi is the Procurement Chairperson and Rhonda Lamberg is the Auction Coordinator.

Fundraiser: Kirtland will perform "My Fatal Valentine"—a murder mystery dinner with a Valentine theme—at the Playhouse on Feb. 23rd. Sindy Fuller reported that our goal is to sell 300 tickets at \$25-\$30 per ticket. The committee will meet with a representative from Kirtland next week.

Program: Tom Rose and Rick Hacker updated the club on the ORV issues. The ORV Task Force has been very active in trying to open up some of our roads to ORV use. At this time townships have the authority to open up their roads to ORV use. This will allow ORVs to come off of the trail systems into town to get gas, eat, etc. Some main concerns are for ice fishing season: from Dec 1st to April 1st, ORVs can access roads within 1 mile of lakes, but will not be allowed on snowmobile trails during this time; and the manner in which the law is worded does not allow all county roads to be open to ORV use, which means that there will need to be access routes. Signs will need to be posted and maps available. However, all seasonal roads will be open to ORVs. Some townships may have these changes in place by January, while other townships may still not allow ORVs on their roads.

Meeting adjourned at 1:00 pm.
