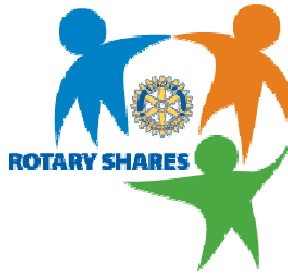

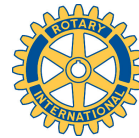

Carolyn stated she will present the request at the club's next board meeting.

Interact: New board members will be elected at this Wednesday's meeting.

Youth Exchange: Dave Hanson announced that he is looking for volunteers to be a host family for our inbound exchange student. A sign up sheet was passed around for anyone interested.

Program: Al Bell from Markey Township gave us an update on the work being done at the Truman-Gardner Park. They have taken out all playground equipment to plant grass, cut down dead trees, and built a new bath house. The current pavilion is only large enough to house 3 picnic tables under it. They are requesting our financial assistance to support building a new larger pavilion. The old pavilion will be reused at the ball fields. The cost for the new pavilion would be \$6000. In exchange for our support the township is willing to put up a Rotary sign at the park. Amy Hance made a motion that the Rotary Club of Houghton Lake allocate up to \$6000 from its Park Fund to be used to purchase materials for Markey Township's "Rotary Pavilion" to be located at the Truman-Gardner Township Park; the motion was seconded by Bill Oliver. The club voted all in favor and the motion passed.
