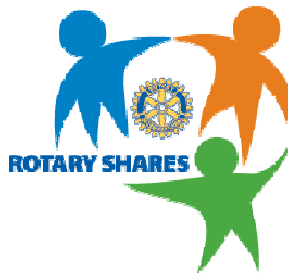

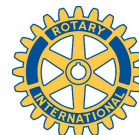

When administering CPR remember 30 compressions to 2 breaths. Compressions should be fast, hard and about 100 per minute. Hands only CPR is when you do not give any breaths, just continue the compressions until emergency services arrive.
