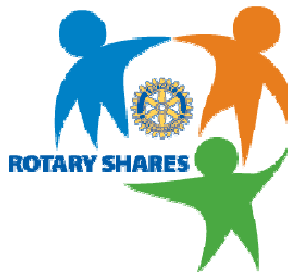

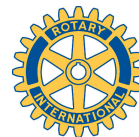

Business meeting called to order at 12:30 pm by Past President, Debbie Banks.

Club, Community and District: Carolyn announced that Bill Oliver was our Rotarian of the Year. Congrats Bill! Scholarships will be announced tonight.

Citizen of the Year: Tom Moreau handed out nomination forms for our Citizen of the Year award. Please bring your nominations to the next meeting.

Interact: Interact members Jacqueline Hallauer and Molly Collins presented our club with three checks from Interact. Interact donated \$100 towards the water project, which our club will match. They also donated \$100 to American Cancer Society and \$100 to Project Hope. Carolyn informed them that Chris Etienne, DG, is requesting an article about the Interact Club to be put into the district newsletter.

Auction: We had 163 people attend the auction. Total ticket sales were 336 with 44 tickets sold at the door. Bert estimated about \$19-20k in sales for the evening. However, there is still about \$1000 not collected yet and we may sell a 2nd Safari Trip.

Program: Bill Wilke from Design Studio & Design Studio Network couldn't be here to speak so Jack gave the presentation. The biggest challenge facing Michigan today is the lack of jobs. The idea of Design Studio is to market and produce a product locally, but sell it nationally. The headquarters would stay local, thus the jobs and profits will remain local. National sales mean higher sales which will result in higher paying jobs. Design Studios are run by gifted and talented teenagers. They act as a bridge to connect the ideas/inventors with the actual production and sales. There are currently 7 Design Studios in place in Michigan.
