## General Meeting of Rotary Club of Houghton Lake held on Sep 22nd, 2008

Program: District Governor, Bob Gandolfi, Official Visit

Bob attended the board meeting at 11:00am and heard about fundraising and project plans for the club for 2008/9. He commented that the Houghton Lake club is very active for its size, particularly in areas such as STRIVE, world community service and Interact. He also reported that the Houghton Lake club surpassed its Foundation giving in 2007/8.

During the main meeting, Bob told the Club about the RI President D K Lee's theme – Make Dreams Real – and what this will mean for children of the world. He emphasized the importance of the PolioPlus Challenge for the total global eradication of Polio. We have a club goal to raise \$1000 for PolioPlus Challenge and Bob asked to do this is a visible way that would enable us to spread the word about the work that is being done in this area. Bob also gave an overview of the District Conference which will be a joint event with District 6360 to be held in Frankenmuth from May 17-19, 2009. He reminded the club of their responsibility to support the conference, both fiscally and in terms of volunteering.

The Club presented Bob and his wife, Diane, with some mementos of Houghton Lake.
