Angie Floriana, Family Services co-coordinator, for the Christmas party for foster children was presented a check for \$1000 toward the December 18 party. This will be held at the Good Shepherd Methodist Church for approximately 50 youth in Roscommon County. The donation will be used to purchase age appropriate gifts for the children. Members of our Club and Interact students will be available to assist in decorating the hall.

John Stark introduced guest speaker Mary Fry, Executive Director for the Roscommon County Community Foundation, which was founded in 1997, becoming independent in 2002. The Foundation conducted a community survey of the problems facing Roscommon County. Findings were: Young families leaving the area, lack of year around employment, school enrollment down, 80% not college bound students, and high school and college graduates leaving the area. Possible solutions are: Vocational training, apprenticeship programs, economic growth and create year around employment. The RCCF has partnered with Michigan Works and is developing a Steering Committee to continue to identify employment needs and continue development of community relationships. With Grants and generous donations from the community, RCCF is able to give scholarships and support numerous projects in the county.
