Reports: Dinner Theatre: Vickie announced a successful evening with 250 persons attending. Comments and suggestions for next year are-welcome.

Bill Oliver reminded members of Ed and Carens Auction on Nov 21 focusing on clothing items for children. Bill gave a run-down of job assignments for the April 24, 2010 Auction to be held at the K of C Hall.

The program was presented by Sheriff Randy Stevenson and Detective Sergeant John Wybraniec of Roscommon County. Det. Sgt Wybraniec recently completed specialized training designed to tracking crime with computer use. Sheriff Randy said the economy has impacted Roscommon County, causing the loss of numerous businesses, and lack of jobs. The Sheriffs Dept. accounts for the largest portion of the budget in the county. The Department received a stimulus which will enabled him to hire additional help toward the enforcement of drug control. Two Grants were received for a total of approximately \$500.000. The Sheriffs Dept. works with the schools to enforce and encourage safety—issuing ID Kits and providing safety material.

A new program (STOPPED) gives law enforcement the right to notify parents of careless behavior of a student while driving a car. The parent first registers the vehicle with the Secretary of State, who then issues a sticker which is placed in the front left window of the vehicle. Law enforcement then knows they are able to notify the parent if necessary.
