Judy introduced our program –Am Red Cross – Disaster Relief, have teams in Rosc Co. Fire Chief, Police Chief determines needs for disaster relief. They give help financially & help to obtain housing. Red Cross received \$100,000 grant last year from Wal-Mart Corp. Covers 13 Counties. There is a Blood Drive Sat Mar 6th at the Our Lady of the Lake School Spa Day. Red Cross has 4 warehouses operating in Haiti with 78 million dollars committed, 1600 patients being treated per day. There is a Fundraiser Feb 28th in Grayling.

Red Cross has programs in place for Armed Forces-Emergency communication for Military Families. They have Recruit drivers to take clients to VA clinics, hospitals, doctor appointments.

The Ash Eve Carnival & Dinner at Our Lady of the Lake School is Tue Feb 16th starting at 4:30p-7p. They put on a wonderful dinner of polish sausage, perogies, and stuffed cabbage rolls etc. Please come help the 7 & 8 grade raise money for their class trip.
