The program was presented by Stephanie Riemer Matuzak, CEO Mercy Hospital Grayling. She gave an overview of the accomplishments of the hospital. Mercy Hospital is owned by Trinity Health (Novi Michigan), the nation's third largest Catholic healthcare organization. The hospital also enjoys an affiliation agreement with Munson Healthcare (Traverse City, Michigan). It has recognition as Top 100 Hospital Performance Improvement Leader and is recipient of Governor's Award for Excellence. The hospital has a service area of over 50,000 people and employs 515 area residents. A group of more than 80 physicians provide health specialties including: anesthesiology, emergency medicine, endocrinology, family practice, general surgery, internal medicine, obstetrics and gynecology, orthopedics, pathology, pediatrics, psychology, radiology, urology, allergy, cardiology, EMT, ophthalmology, neurosurgery, podiatry, rehabilitation and sleep disorder medicine. Reinvestments of almost \$15 million over the past five years have been made to the Emergency Department, surgical unit, newborn, ambulatory surgery department, outpatient services, as well as renovations to the lobby and first floor areas. Stephanie has been with Grayling Mercy Hospital since 1983 and CEO since 1999.
