General Meeting of Rotary Club of Houghton Lake Held on May 3, 2010

Meeting Opened at 12:15 by President Sindy Fuller, followed by pledge and prayer.

Guests present: six.

PDG Bob Gandolfi inducted into membership, Brad Urbach and Susan Tyer.

Chad Kelly announced the Higgins Lake Sunrise Run June 19. Five hundred runners are expected to register for the event which starts at the Higgins Lake North State Park and ends at the Higgins Lake South State Park. In addition to the half marathon, race day will include a 10K, 5K, run/walk and Fun Run/Walk for children and families. All proceeds benefit non-motorized trail development around Higgins Lake, the Shop with a Cop-Kids program and the Roscommon Area Youth Booster Club to support Academic, Arts and Athletic programs.

Tom Moreau gave a preliminary financial report on the Auction. After several outstanding bills the Club may realize over \$21,000 from the event. A final report will be presented in the future.

The program was presented by Deb Roscyk and Millie Mellgren on the Roscommon County Literacy Program. The program promotes literacy and makes available to adults and children a tutoring program. The Roscommon Literacy Program is working with the Dollywood Foundation, created by Dolly Parton, to promote reading to children starting with infants. The Foundation created the Imagination Library which gives the child a book every month from birth to 5 years. Organizations can help financially with the program (the cost being \$30 /year/child which is 12 books per year). A child must be signed up for the program in order to receive the books. Our Club will discuss this program at the next board meeting.
