The program was presented by the Central Michigan Health Department on the new non-smoking ban in public businesses. The law was signed in December 2009 and went into effect in May 2010. There are many areas of this bill to be worked on and clarified. There is no designated distance from the business and the ban includes private clubs and AA which is being challenged. A business can sell smoking items but no smoking is allowed. E-cigarettes are acceptable but not approved by the FDA. Offices in a home are exempt only if no customers enter. Still many areas need to be fine-tuned and possibly be changed.
